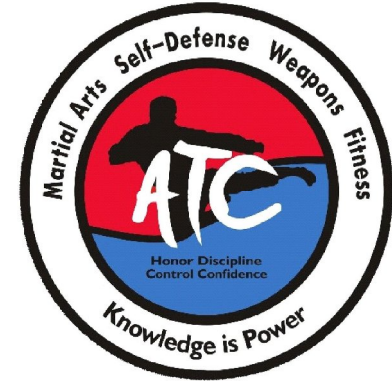
ATC's goal is to build stronger confident leaders for a better tomorrow.

- 6) Children should maintain top academic grades and practice TaeKwon-Do 15 minutes per day at home. "Stretching"
- 7) Children should eat healthy food and avoid horse-playing, fighting, profanity or negative attitudes.
- 8) Students must attend at least 2 to 3 classes per week to help in their training
- 9) Students should set positive leadership goals.
- 10) Students should stick to their commitments.
- 11) Students should remember they are leaders.
- 12) Students must refer one new member per belt in order to keep a top academy.
- 13) When you bring a friend in and they join, you will be awarded 20 TKD Dollars or a free Uniform or T-Shirt.
- 14) Students must test when they have earned a minimum of 5 stripes. ATC tests students on their individual merits.
- 15) Fear of testing is normal. Remember that fear is a negative reaction which creates only doubt in one's abilities. We are Martial Arts professionals and know if a student is ready to test. **Privates are available to stay on track.**

Testing Eligibility

Home Report Card

In order for a child to receive their red stripe and be eligible to test for the next belt, they must return this home report card with their testing application and most recent school report card.

Pre-testing Report Card

- 1) If a instructor sees some areas you are falling behind in, he will fill out the pre-test report so a student can work on those areas.
- 2) If a student is falling behind due to missed classes or any other difficulties the instructor will fill out a pre-testing report and re-check your improvement in three days.
- 3) If the instructor sees any areas that need extra work he will recommend several private classes to stay on track with the other students.
- 4) If a student does not maintain the required training or attitude they will be expelled for that class.
- 5) After the 3rd expulsion there will be a parent, student instructor meeting.
- 6) Do not use TaeKwondo as a punishment. Schedule a time so your child can talk with an instructor. The instructor will use pushup, remove tips or hold back testing as a punishment.
